What is a Community Development Strategic Plan?

A **Community Development Strategic Plan** establishes a community's vision with specific goals and strategies to revitalize the local economy and guide future growth. The strategy is intended to provide local government, businesses, and citizens with a "road map" for planning, implementing, and monitoring the progress of community revitalization.

Project Outcomes

The **Strategic Plan** will include an analysis of the Town's population and socio-economic conditions; the hamlet's local business district; existing land uses, future development needs and areas to promote infill development; the community's existing and future water and wastewater needs; a housing conditions survey; and an opportunity for community-involvement. The resulting plan will be used to:

- Access future grant opportunities from State and Federal funding sources;
- Address substandard housing conditions within the Town;
- Identify economic development opportunities; and
- Identify infrastructure needs within the Town.
